

It is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. That the Complainant shall have the full care, custody and control of their minor children, Michael Payne Best, Donald Gibson Best, III and McKay Payne Best, and the Respondent shall have the right to visit such children at reasonable and proper times. The Respondent shall also have a right of custody during limited periods of vacations, at the expense of the Respondent, as shall be agreed to and at such times as shall seem proper to the Complainant.
- 2. It is further stipulated and agreed that the Complainant shall convey to the Respondent the family automobile now used by the Complainant.
- 3. All personal property owned by the parties shall be sold at a convenient time, except said family car, and the proceeds of such sale shall be divided equally between Complainant and Respondent.
- 4. It is further stipulated and agreed between the parties hereto that the Respondent shall pay the Complainant as and for support
 and maintenance of the said minor children as follows:
- (a) Until 1 July, 1956 the sum of \$150.00 per month in two equal monthly payments on or about the 1st and the 16th day of each month.
- (b) Beginning the 1st day of July, 1956 and during the period through the 31st day of December, 1956, the Respondent shall pay \$50.00 per month in two equal installments on or about the 1st and the 16th day of each month.
- (c) Beginning 1 January, 1957 and each month thereafter until such time as the children shall reach their legal age, the Respondent shall pay \$50.00 per month payable in two equal installments on or

about the 1st and 16th day of each month. In addition thereto the Respondent shall deposit in a trust fund to be established by him \$50.00 per month for the benefit of the said minor children and the Respondent does hereby agree to create and establish the aforesaid trust. The above payments are to continue until such time as the children marry or become of age or until changed by proper order of a Court of competent jurisdiction.

That your Complainant and the Respondent are over the age of twenty-one years and are bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing in Fairhope, Alabama.

SECOND:

That the Complainant and the Respondent were married on, to-wit, November 26, 1953 in Mobile, Alabama and lived together as man and wife until on, to-wit, March 24, 1956, when, on account of the matters hereinafter complained of, your Complainant was compelled to live separate and apart from the Respondent; that on March 24, 1956 and

at times prior to that the Complainant states that the Respondent from his manner and conduct towards her gave reasonable apprehension of committing violence on her person and from his manner and conduct towards her she is reasonably certain that he will commit such violence upon her person, attended with danger to her life or health.

THIRD:

The Complainant and Respondent have the following named children, viz: Michael Payne Best, five years of age, and Donald Gibson Best, III and McKay Payne Best, nine months of age. That your Complainant is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of such children. That your Complainant has no money or property with which to properly support and educate such children and that the Respondent is able to pay your Complainant such sufficient amounts to properly support and educate such children.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that the above named Donald G. Best be made a party Defendant to this cause by the usual writ or process, requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause that Your Honor will award your Complainant custody and control of her minor children herein named and will order and decree that the Respondent shall pay to your Complainant a reasonable sum as and for support of such children. Your Honor will also grant unto the Complainant an absolute divorce from said Respondent and will decree that the parties be allowed to remarry if they see fit and that the Respondent is not to harass your Complainant in any way or means. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to her such other, further and different relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
