The complainant avers that she is a just and proper person to have the care, control and custody of the said minor children.

The premises considered, your complainant prays that your Honor will order service to be had according to law upon said respondent, commanding him to appear and plead, answer and demur to this bill of complaint within the time required by law and that your Honor will hold a hearing and award the Complainant temporary care, control and custody of the said minor children, pending this suit, and that upon a final hearing of this cause, that your Honor will render a decree divorcing your complainant from the respondent and granting the complainant permanent care, control and custody of the said minor children and permanent alimony for her support and maintenance and support and maintenance for the said minor children.


