This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ on ANSWER AND WAIVER and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is futher ordered that Leroy Walker the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

married on, to-wit, April 18, 1958.


3. Complainant further avers that said Respondent volun-

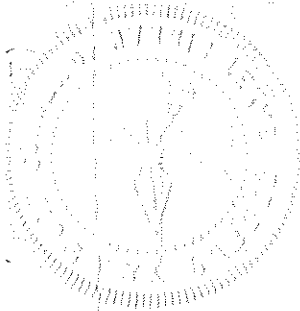


