It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that William Wilson the defendant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

Comes your Complainant, Ada Lavonia Wilson, and hum-
bly complaining against William Wilson, Defendant, and respect-
fully shows unto your Honor:

FIRST: That your Complainant is nineteen years of age
and is a resident of the Town of Loxley, Baldwin County, Alabama,
where she has resided all of her life.

SECOND: That the said Defendant is over the age of twenty-
one years and is a resident of the Town of Silverhill, Baldwin
County, Alabama, where he has resided for the past ten years.

THIRD: That your Complainant and the said Defendant were
married in the City of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, on
the 18th day of April, 1959, and lived together as husband and wife,
in the said town of Silverhill, Baldwin County, Alabama, until
the 3rd day of June, 1959.

FOURTH: That the said Defendant did on to-wit: the 3rd day
of June, 1959, at their home in the town of Silverhill, without
provocation became enraged at your Complainant and beat her unner-
cifully and drove her from their home and told her that if she
returned he would kill her. That because of his actual violence
and threats she has reasonable cause to believe and does believe
that should she return to their home he would do her bodily harm
attendant with danger to her life or health.

WHEREFORE, your Complainant prays that this Honorable
Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of
complaint and make the said William Wilson party Defendant hereto

and by appropriate process require him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between this complainant and the said defendant and complainant prays for such other, further or different relief as in equity and good conscience she shall be entitled to receive in the premises.

My name is Ada Lavonia Wilson. I am the complainant in the above cause. I am 19 years of age and live in the town of Loxley, Baldwin County, Alabama, where I have lived all of my life. I married William Wilson, the defendant in this case in the Court House in the City of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 18th day of April, 1959, We lived together as husband and wife in the town of Silverhill, Alabama, until the 3rd day of June, 1959. On that day the defendant came home from his work and was ~~sed~~ that he hit me with his fist in my mouth and brock one of my front teeth. He works at night with the Alabama Wood Preserving Company in Roberts- dale and get home about 7 o'clock in the morning. He ordered me out of the house and told me to get my things and go back home to my parents in Loxley and that if I ever came back there he would kill me. While I was getting my things together he hit me again in the eye and black my eye, which stayed that way for several days. I did not do anything to him to provoke him and tried to make our marriage work, but from his conduct and treatment of me for the short time that we were married I was forced to leave him for fear of my life and health and moved back with my parents in Loxley, where I have remained since that date. I have reasonable grounds to believe that should I return to live with him that he would inflict grave bodily harm to my life or health.
