ANSWER AND CROSS-BILL:

Now comes the Respondent in the above styled cause, and for answer to the Bill of Complaint heretofore filed in this cause says:

- l. He admits the allegations contained in paragraph l relative to the age and residence of the Respondent but he denies the allegations that the Complainant is an owner of an undivided interest in and to the lands described in the Bill of Complaint and demand strict proof thereof.
- 2. He admits that he is over the age of twenty-one years and resides at Little River, Alabama, but denies that he is the owner of an undivided one-half interest in the lands described in the Bill of Complaint and shows unto the court that he is the owner in fee simple of all of the lands described in the said Bill of Complaint.
- 3. He admits the allegations of paragraph 3 of the Bill of Complaint.
- 4. He denies the allegations of paragraph 4 of the Bill of Complaint and demands strict proof thereof.
- 5. He denies the allegations of paragraph 5 of the Bill of Complaint and demands strict proof thereof.

For further answer to the Bill of Complaint and by way of Cross-Bill, the Respondent and Cross-Complainant shows unto the Court and your Honor as follows:

A. The Respondent and Cross-Complainant is the owner of and is in peaceable possession of the lands described in the Bill of Complaint, to-wit:




