This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Answer and Waiver~~ on Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Vivian Callaway Peed is forever divorced from the said Billy Gene Peed for and on account of abandonment; it is further ordered, adjudged, and decreed that the said Vivian Callaway Peed may resume and have again the use of her maiden name, Callaway.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Vivian Callaway Peed the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

TO THE HONORABLE H.M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Comes your Complainant, Vivian Callaway Peed, and respectfully avers and shows unto Your Honor and to this Court as follows:

1. That both your Complainant and the Respondent are over the age of twenty-one years and are bona fide resident citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of this cause.

2. That your Complainant and the Respondent were lawfully married at Folkston, Georgia, on, to-wit: the 10th day of April, 1957, and ever since have been and are now husband and wife. That there have been no issue born of said marriage.

3. Your Complainant further avers and charges that on the 24th day of August, 1957, the Respondent without cause or justification separated from and abandoned the said Complainant, and since that day has not lived with her as consort, nor furnished her any support nor offered to furnish her any support nor bed and board.

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that the Respondent be made a Party Respondent to this Bill of Complaint by the usual process of this honorable Court, and the statutes in such cases made and provided requiring him to plead, answer, or demur within the time and in the manner provided by law; and that on the final hearing of this cause that your Honor will enter a decree divorcing your Complainant from the said Respondent, granting both parties the right to re-marry, granting the Complainant the right to resume the use of her maiden name, and Complainant further prays that Your Honor will grant such other, further, different, and general relief to which the Complainant may be entitled

as in duty bound she will ever pray.





I, Velma C. MONTGOMERY, as Register and Commissioner, have called and caused to come before me Vivian Callaway Peed and Lillian S. Callaway, witnesses named in the requirement for oral examination, on the 15th day of MARCH, 1959, at the office of James A. Brice in Foley, Alabama, and having first sworn said witnesses to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Vivian Callaway Peed doth depose and say as follows:

"My name is Vivian Callaway Peed; I am the complainant in that certain divorce action instituted by me against Billy Gene Peed; Mr. Peed and I are both resident citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama, and both of us are over the age of twenty-one years; we were married on April 10, 1957, at Folkston, Georgia, and we moved into our home at Gulf Shores, Alabama, shortly thereafter; we lived there together as husband and wife until August 24, 1957, on which day we abandoned our residence and my husband abandoned me; I moved in with my parents, and my husband began residing as a bachelor; we have not lived together since that day, nor has he furnished me any support or offered to furnish any, nor furnished any bed and board."

And for answer to the Bill of Complaint heretofore filed in this cause, Respondent says:

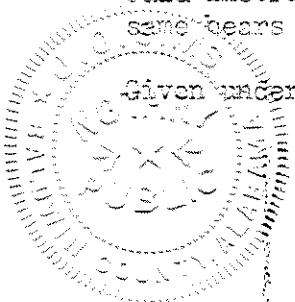
1. He admits the allegations contained in Paragraph One of said Bill of Complaint.

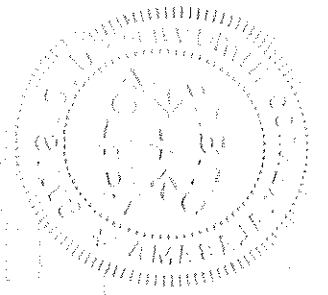
