The value of this car at the time he carried it away was \$250.00 and I know that to be a reasonable value since I have bought and sold cars. I respectfully ask that the respondent be ordered to pay the sum of \$250.00 to me for this automobile and further ask that I be granted a divorce. I further ask that I be granted the right to resume the use of my maiden name Faye Skipper. We were married at Leaksville, Mississippi.
