That my name is Faye Skipper Welch, I am over the age of 21 and have been a resident of Alabama more than two years next preceding, The respondent Harold E. Welch, is over the age of 21 and has also been a resident of Alabama more than two years next preceding. We were married on June 27, 1958 and lived together in Alabama as husband and wife until I was forced to leave him on February 23, 1959 because of his abuse and mistreatment placing me in fear of my life or health. He would lose his temper without cause and beat and strike me and his actions since our separation are requiring that I obtain a peace warrant in order to have some protection from him. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and none expected. I know that we will never live together again as husband and wife. There is a 1950 Chevrolet 2door Belaire Sedan which was my property before we were married and which the respondent carried off and concealed or disposed of depriving me of its use. The value of this car at the time he carried it away was \$250.00 and I know that to be a reasonable value since I have bought and sold cars. I respectfully ask that the respondent be ordered to pay the sum of \$250.00 to me for this automobile and further ask that I be granted a divorce. I further ask that I be granted the right to resume the use of my maiden name Faye Skipper. We were married at Leaksville, Mississippi.

That my name is Shelby Jean Skipper, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and have been residents of Alabama more than 2 years next preceding. They were married in Leaksville, Mississippi on June 27, 1958 and separated in Alabama on February 23, 1959. The complainant had to leave the respondent because he beat and abused her placing her in fear of her life or health. I do not believe they will ever live together again as husband and wife. There are no children born as fruits of this marriage. The complainant had a 1950 Chevrolet 2door Belaire Automobile which the respondent had last.

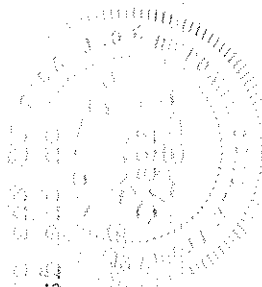
