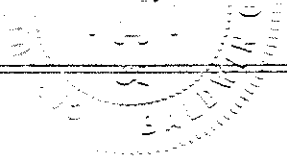

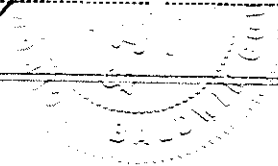

2. That on, to-wit, the 23 day of August
1924 said Wickersham and Russ and their said wives and one

into a contract with complainant for the sale to him of the land
hereinafter described which said land is situated in Baldwin
County, Alabama, and which said contract is recorded in Deed Book



The defendants in this cause having heretofore on November 2nd., 1927, filed their motion to require that security for costs be given by the complainant and the Court on heretofore to-wit: December 3rd., 1927, having heard said motion made and entered following order and decree, viz:-

"This cause coming on to be heard in open court on motion of respondents to require complainant to give security for costs and respondents and complainants appearing by their respective solicitors of record, and upon consideration of the motion and the evidence submitted in support thereof, it is;

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the complainant be and he is hereby required to give security for costs of this cause in the sum of \$200.00 to be approved by the Register.


