This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on Personal Service and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Louise Steege Parker is forever divorced from the said Gordon Parker for and on account of Cruelty.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Louise Steege Parker the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

more than two years next preceeding. We were married at Lucedale, Mississippi
on October 29, 1955 and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin
County until on or about June 7, 1956. On this occasion the Respondent
without fault on my part choked and slapped me so that I was placed in fear
of my life or health and I had him arrested because of this treatment. I
am afraid to live with him anymore as his wife and will not live with him
anymore. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property
to be divided. I respectfully ask this Honorable Court for a divorce.

That my name is Vera Chastang, I know both parties to this cause.
They are both over the age of 21 and have been residents of Baldwin County,
Alabama more than two years. They were married in Lucedale, Mississippi
on or about October 29, 1955 and lived together as husband and wife in
Baldwin County, Alabama until on or about June 7, 1956. On that night the
Respondent choked and struck Louise so that she was afraid to live with
him as his wife and because she was in fear of her life or health she has
not lived with him as his wife since that time. They have no children as
fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I do not believe
they will ever live together again as husband and wife.

That on June 7, 1956, and on several occasions prior thereto the Respondent
threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence
to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct
of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable
apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to
live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person,
which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

There are no children as fruits of this marriage, and there is no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will, by proper process make the said Gordon Parker, party Respondent to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law, and the practice of this Honorable Court; Your Complainant further prays that your Honor will upon a final hearing hereof, award to her a decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and the Respondent.

Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be entitled in the premises, etc.
