This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ on Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said June Anice Bundy is forever divorced from the said O. J. Bundy for and on account of Cruelty.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant, June Anice Bundy, shall resume the use of her former name of Dickman.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that June Anice Bundy the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

We were married at Lucedale, Mississippi on May 20, 1956 and lived together as husband and wife a little over two weeks at which time we separated. The cause of the separation being the abuse and misuse of my person by the Respondent who flew into a rage and struck me placing me in fear of my life or health and I had to leave him. I will never live with him again as his wife. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I respectfully ask that I be granted a divorce. I respectfully request the right to use my former name of Dickman.

That my name is Mrs. Irene Langham, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been more than two years next preceeding. They were married in Lucedale, Mississippi on May 20, 1956 and lived together but a short time. the separation being caused by the Respondent striking and threatening the Complainant placing her in fear of her life or health. I do not believe they will ever live together again as husband and wife. There are no children as fruits of that marriage and no property to be divided.

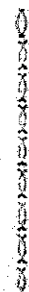


