Herman has been mean to me nearly every since we have been married and he has beat me several times. WE had been living in Bon Secour, Alabama up and until about a year ago when he got a chance to go to Lugoff, SOUth Carolina and get a job on a new plant that was been built there as a carpenters helper. I Went up there after he had been there a couple of weeks to live with him there while he was on that job. HE made better money than he had been used to making and started to spend quite a bit on drinking. HE began getting meaner and meaner to me and the babyand finally one night he came home after he had been drinking and the baby was not feeling good. HE slapped the baby very hard and cursed her to make her stop crying and then when I Shid something to him for doing it he jumped on me and knocked me down and threatened to kill me and the baby both.
