Now comes your complainant, by her Solicitors, and respectfully show unto this Honorable Court as follows:

- 1. That the complainant is over the age of 21 years and is a resident of Mobile County, Alabama; that the respondent is over the age of 21 and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. That the complainant and the respondent, Sarah Rudolph, are each the owner of an undivided one-half interest in the following described property situated in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

From the Southwest corner of Section 16, T. 2 S., R. 3 E., run North 299.5 feet, for a point of beginning; thence run North 388.5 feet; thence run North 88 degrees 25 minutes East, 315 feet; thence run South 76.8 feet; thence run South 79 degrees 41 minutes West, 98.2 feet; thence run South 01 degree 02 minutes West, 322.7 feet; thence run North 85 degrees 34 minutes West, 213.2 feet to the point of beginning; Lot contains 2.2 acres, and lies in the SW2 of Section 16, T. 2 S., R. 3 E., Baldwin County, Alabama.
