This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~X Decree X Pro X Cont X Ex X Oth~~ Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Joyce V. Brokowsky is forever divorced from the said Charles Robert Brokowsky for and on account of Abandonment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant, Joyce V. Brokowsky, shall have the permanent care, custody and control of the minor child, William Michael Brokowsky, age about 6 years.

It is futher ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is futher ordered that Joyce V. Brokowsky the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

The respondent is over the age of 21 years and is presently residing in Grand Rapids, Michigan. We were married on February 15, 1950, and lived together as husband and wife until the Respondent abandoned me in October 1953 without fault on my part. We have not lived together as husband and wife since that date. There were born as fruit of our marriage one child, William Michael Brokowsky, May 14, 1953. The Petitioner has had constant care custody and control and Respondent requests that she be given his permanent care custody and control. The Petitioner further adds that she does not believe that they will ever live together as husband and wife and respectfully ask this Honorable Court for a divorce.

My name is Raymond M. Eckart. I know both parties of this cause. They are both over the age of 21 years and that the Complainant has been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama since birth, and that the Respondent is presently residing in Grand Rapids, Michigan, that they were married in Lansing Michigan on or about the 15th of February, 1950, and lived there as husband and wife until on or about some time in October 1953 at which time the Respondent abandoned the Complainant without fault of her part. I feel that I know they have not lived together as husband and wife since that date. There has been as fruit of that marriage one child, William Michael Brokowsky, and is about the age of 6 years. The Complainant has had the care custody and control of that child since birth and I respectfully represent that this Honorable Court that the Complainant is a fit, suitable and proper to have the care custody and control of this minor child. WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Charles Robert Brokowsky, party respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the respondent; that a decree be made awarding to the complainant the care, custody and control of the minor child, William Michael Brokowsky, age over 5 years old; your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
