FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for Final Decree upon the Petition of Ada Y. Vanderford, and the Affidavits of Robert E. Ferrell Jr and L.S. Baggett praying that Jesse F. Tomlinson be relieved of the disabilities of non-age and, upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the minor, Jesse F. Tomlinson, is entitled to the relief prayed for in the petition of Ada Y. Vanderford, and that it is to the best interests of the said Jesse F. Tomlinson, that he be relieved of the disabilities of non-age; It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the prayer of said Petitioner be granted, and that the said Jesse F. Tomlinson, a minor, be relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and that he be granted the right to transact his own business; to contract and be contracted with; to sue and be sued; and generally to do and perform all acts which he could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age; It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Petitioner pay the cost in this proceedings incurred for which execution may issue.

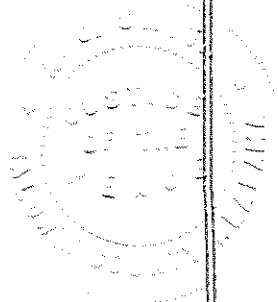
