Boone have not lived together since that time; that your Complainant was without fault in the said abandonment.


THIRD:

Complainant further shows unto your Honor that there were born unto your Complainant and the said C. L. Boone three children, namely: Anna Luverne Boone, age ten years, Eric Daniel Boone, age eight years, and Thomas Edison Boone, age four years; that said

children are in the custody of your Complainant; that the said C. L. Boone is an indolent person and is practically always without employment, and has made no contribution toward the support of said children; that he is not a suitable person to have the custody and control of the said children.




