This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree and Answer~~ WAIVER AND ANSWER and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said ILENA ALLEN VINSON is forever divorced from the said NORMAN E. VINSON for and on account of "CRUELTY"

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the complainant, ILENA ALLEN VINSON, be, and she is hereby, authorized and empowered to resume the use of her maiden name, ILENA ALLEN.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that ILENA ALLEN VINSON the complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

doth depose and say as follows: "My name is ILENA ALLEN VINSON. I am the complainant in this cause and I am over the age of seventeen years. I am a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. The respondent, NORMAN E. VINSON, is over the age of twenty-one years and is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. I was married to the respondent on the 11th day of September, 1955, at Leaksville, Mississippi. We lived together as husband and wife until about the 2nd of July, 1956, when I was forced to leave me husband. Shortly after we married my husband began to exhibit extreme jealousy and a high temper. Without any justification, he would accuse me of having affairs with other men and would threaten to kill me. He came home on furlough from the Army a few days ago, and accused me of running around with other men, and again threatened to do physical violence to my person. I became convinced that, if I continued to live with him as his wife, he would carry out his threats and do physical violence to my person which would be dangerous to my life or health. For that reason, I left him, and, under existing conditions, I do not believe we can ever live together as husband and wife. We have no children and no community property." 

forced to leave his bed and board on, to-wit: the 2nd day of July,
1956.

4. That there are no children of this marriage.

WHEREFORE, THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Your complainant makes the
said NORMAN E. VINSON a party respondent to this her bill of complaint,
and in order that complainant may have the relief hereinafter prayed
for, may it please your Honors to cause the State's Writ of Subpoena
to be issued, directed to the said NORMAN E. VINSON, commanding him
to plead, answer or demur to this bill of complaint within the time
required by law; and that on a final hearing of this cause your Honor
will make and enter a decree divorcing the complainant from the re-
