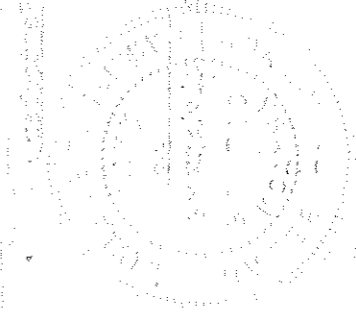

That my name is Aubrey Wilson. I am over the age of 21 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been more than two years next preceding. The respondent is over the age of 20 years and is presently residing in Louisiana. We were married on May 5, 1956 and lived together for eight days, when the respondent abandoned me without fault on my part and disappeared. I found her on or about the first of August, and on August 6th we again began living together as husband and wife. On August 14th, she again left me and went over where she is now with another man, whose name is unknown to me, but I am convinced is not her father or brother. Before she left the last time, I know that she was seeing some else, but I could only glimpse him, and when I demanded the facts and his identity, she packed up and went off with him. We have no children as fruits of our marriage and she was not pregnant when she left, and I want my divorce before anything happens now. I have not lived with her as husband and wife since August 14. I know that we will never live together again as husband and wife after she went off this last time. She wants her maiden name back, and I want her to have it. We have no property to be divided.

That my name is Mrs. Louise West, I know both parties to this cause. The Complainant, Aubrey Wilson, is over the age of 21 and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and has been such more than two years next preceding. The Respondent is over the age of 18 and has gone back to Louisiana where I understand she presently lives. They were married on May 5, 1956 at Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together hardly a week when the Respondent disappeared and was not heard from until some time in August. They began living together as husband and wife again around the 5th or 6th of August and a little over a week later the Respondent left again with a man whose name to me is unknown. From what I have learned in this matter the Respondent is living with this other man in Winnefield, Louisiana. I do not know of any property which these parties have had that might be divided nor have I any knowledge of whether or not the Respondent was pregnant at the time of her last departure. I do not believe the parties will ever live together again as husband and wife.
