

Now comes your Complainants, George L. Ellis and Juanita Ellis, in the above entitled cause and file this, their bill of complaint, in equity, against the Respondent, Forrest V. Weekley, and represent and show unto Your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

F I R S T

That the Complainants and the Respondent are all over the age of twenty-one years and are all bona fide resident citizens of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama; that your Complainants reside in the Town of Fairhope and the Respondent, Forrest V. Weekley, resides at Perdido, Alabama.

S E C O N D

That your Complainants are in the actual, peaceable possession of that certain real property, constituting a house and lot known as 560 Grand Avenue, Fairhope, Alabama, and more particularly described as:

Lot Six (6) in Block Thirteen (13) of Volanta as per plat recorded in Miscellaneous Book One (1) of the Probate Records of Baldwin County, Alabama,

and that your Complainants claim to own said land with the improvements thereon in their own right.

T H I R D

Your Complainants further aver that the Respondent claims or is reputed to claim some right, title, interest, lien or encumbrance in, on, or to said real property with the improvements thereon hereinabove described and your Complainants now call upon said Respondent to set forth and specify his title, claim, interest, lien or encumbrance, and how and by what instrument the same is alleged to be derived and created.

F O U R T H

Your Complainants further state that there is no suit pending to enforce or test the validity of such title, claim or encumbrance upon said real property and Your Complainants now bring this suit to settle the title to said property and to clear up all doubts and disputes concerning the same; your Complainants do hereby offer to do equity in the premises and to abide by the decree of this Honorable Court.

F I F T H

Your Complainants further allege that the Respondent claims or is reputed to claim an interest in or to own said real property herein described in and by virtue of a tax deed from W. R. Stuart, as Judge of the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, on behalf of the State of Alabama for alleged delinquent taxes due by one Tice Clark, conveying the State of Alabama's claim to said land for taxes allegedly due, which the State of Alabama obtained from a sale of said land for such taxes allegedly due and unpaid in the name of Tice Clark. Your Complainants further allege that they are the vendees of John White and Elaine White, his wife, by warranty deed executed by them on the 28th day of May, 1955, said Grantors being the legal title holders and owners of said property, having acquired same from Dr. H. Claudius Jordan and Mary R. Jordan, his wife, by warranty deed dated the 28th day of May, 1955, and that your Complainants are entitled to redeem said real property from the Respondent as provided by law under Title 51, Section 296, under the subject of "Redemption of Land Sold for Taxes" and the subject "Rights and Remedies of Purchasers at Tax Sales" of the Code of Alabama, 1940.



P R A Y E R F O R P R O C E S S

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainants pray that the said Respondent, Forrest V. Weekley, be made the party respondent to this bill of complaint and that process be issued from the Honorable Court requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same as required by law and by the rules and practice of this Honorable Court.

P R A Y E R F O R R E L I E F

Your Complainants further pray that upon a hearing of this bill of complaint should said Respondent establish to the satisfaction of this

Honorable Court a claim to said real property under and by virtue of a tax sale as aforesaid or as evidenced by proof, that this Honorable Court shall determine and ascertain the exact amount paid by the purchaser at the sale and of the exact amount of taxes subsequently paid by said purchaser, if any, together with the legal rate of interest as provided by law per annum thereon and shall further decree that upon the payment of such amount as ascertained and determined by this Court by your Complainants unto this Honorable Court that such Respondent has no further estate, claim, interest or demand in or encumbrance on said real property, with the improvements thereon, or any part thereof. Your Complainants further pray that should said Respondent fail to prove to the satisfaction of this Honorable Court such claim or interest in said real property that this Honorable Court shall forthwith decree that said Respondent, Forrest V. Weekley, has no estate or interest in or encumbrance on such real property, or any part thereof; your Complainants further pray for all such other, further and different relief as they may be entitled in equity to receive, the premises considered, and your Complainants herewith offer to do equity as may be decreed by this Honorable Court.


