This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Macie H. McCorry King is forever divorced from the said Alfred B. King for and on account of Abandonment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the care, custody and control of Jimmie Fay King, is awarded the Complainant herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the Respondent shall pay to the Complainant the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per month as maintenance and support for John Phillip King fruits of a former marriage of these parties, the care custody and control of this child having been given the Complainant herein on a former divorce.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Macie H. McCorry King the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

LeNoir Thompson in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness es to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Macie H. McCroory King and Mary E. Hubbart doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Macie H. McCroory King, I am over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been more than two years next preceding. The Respondent Alfred B. King is also over the age of 21 and has been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama for more than two years next preceding. We were married December 22, 1950 at Lucedale, Mississippi and we lived together as husband and wife until on or about November 5, 1953. There was born as fruits of this marriage which was our second, one child Jimmie Fay King now about five years of age. The Respondent abandoned your petitioner without fault on her part and since the abandonment has made no provision for support of your petitioner or of Jimmie Fay King, child of the second marriage or of John Phillip King a child of our first marriage. In contemplation of this divorce the Respondent has agreed that \$50.00 a month is a reasonable support for the child of our first marriage and your petitioner agrees to accept same as a reasonable support of said child. In view of the abandonment your petitioner is sure that the parties to this cause will never live together again as husband and wife and since she has ad the care custody and control of both children since birth she respectfully ask this Honorable Court to grant her the care custody and control of the second child Jimmie Fay King since such custody was granted by the court of the older in the former divorce.

That my name is Mary E. Hubbart, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and have been residents of Baldwin County, Alabama more than two years next preceding. They were married the last time on December 22, 1950 at Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together until on or about November 5, 1953 at which time the Respondent abandoned the Complainant without fault on her part. There was one child Jimmie Fay King age about five years born of this last marriage and the Complainant has had the care, custody and control of this child since her birth, in addition to having the care custody and control of John Phillip King age about seven years born of a prior marriage between the parties to this cause. I respectfully submit that the Complainant is a fit suitable and proper person to have the care custody and control of Jimmie Fay King and this Honorable Court having already granted the care custody and control to her of the older child in a former divorce. I do not believe these parties will ever live together again as husband and wife.



WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Alfred B. King, party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

That your Complainant be awarded the care, custody and control of the minor children, John Phillip King, age about 7 years and Jimmie Fay King, age about 5 years; that your Honor will grant to the Complainant permanent maintenance for said children in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per month.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to both parties an absolute decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between the Complainant and the Respondent and that a decree be made awarding the Complainant, who now has the care, custody and control of the minor children, John Phillip King, age about 7 years and Jimmie Fay King, age about 5 years, the care, custody and control of said children pending further orders of this court; and your Complainant further prays that your Honor will determine the sum of \$50.00 per month as a reasonable amount for the support and maintenance of said minor children; Your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
