It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Frank Ball the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.



Bailey, in Fairhope, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witnesses to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Opal G. Ball and Dale A. Raddcliffe doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Opal G. Ball. I am over twenty-one years old and have lived in Baldwin County, Alabama, for more than the past year; Frank Ball is over the age of twenty-one years old and is now living in Birmingham, Alabama. Frank and I were married on February 6, 1948, at Columbus, Mississippi. Frank has made many threats of doing me bodily harm and I am reasonably convinced that should I continue to live with him, he will commit an actual violence upon me which would endanger my life and health; the last of such threats occurred on about October 1, 1956, and since that time and as a result of said threats, Frank and I have not lived together nor have we in any way recognized each other as husband and wife. I was the mother of two children by a previous marriage and these two children were legally adopted by Frank Ball, the Respondent in this case; the children were Ronnie Foster Ball, a boy, 13 years old, and Patricia Ann Ball, a girl, 11 years old; these children are now in my custody, I am their mother; and I feel that I am a fit and proper person to be awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the said minor children.

Opal G. Ball

I have known Opal Ball for more than the past two years. She is over twenty-one years old and has lived in Fairhope, Alabama, for more than the past year; Frank Ball is over twenty-one years old and is now living in Birmingham, Alabama. Opal and Frank were married at Columbus, Mississippi, on February 6, 1948. I have heard Frank make threats of doing Opal physical harm, and it is my opinion that should they continue to live together as husband and wife, he will commit an actual violence upon her which would endanger her life and health; they have not lived together since the first part of October, of 1956, and I believe it was his attitude toward her which caused the separation. Opal had two children by a former marriage and these children were legally adopted by Frank Ball, namely, Ronnie Foster Ball, a boy, 13 years old and Patricia Ann Ball, a girl, 11 years old; these children are now in the care, custody and control of the Complainant, Opal Ball, their mother, and I feel that she is a fit and proper person to be awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the said minor children.

That said children are now in the custody of the Complainant, their mother; Complainant further avers that she is a fit and proper person to be awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the said minor children. Complainant further avers that the Respondent is an able bodied man and is well able to aid in the maintenance and support of the said minor children as set out herein.


PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Direct Examination by Mr. Chason.

Q. What is your name?

A. Francis Shelly.

Q. Where do you live?

A. Mobile, Alabama.

Q. Are you connected with Nelson Radio & Supply Company, Inc., a
Corporation?

A. I am.

Q. What is your connection?

A. First Vice President.

Q. Were you so connected with such Company on June 4, 1956?

A. I was, sir.

Q. Is the Nelson Radio & Supply Company a Corporation?

A. It is.

A. Mobile, Alabama.

Q. Is Gulf State Enterprise a Corporation?

A. Yes sir, it is.

Q. Under the Laws of what state?

A. Florida.

Q. Do you know where its principal place of business is?

A. Pensacola, Florida.

Q. Mr. Shelly, on June 4, 1956, did the Complainant Corporation enter into a contract with the Respondent Corporation to sell them certain kitchen cabinets, sinks and other materials to be installed in three separate dwelling houses which were being erected by the defendant at that time?

A. We did.

Q. Now who entered into the agreement on behalf of your Corporation?

A. Mr. John Rowell, as a salesman of ours is the man that did the transaction of the business.

Q. Was that under your supervision?

A. Yes sir, I am directly over him.

Q. On behalf of the Respondent Corporation, who acted for them?

A. Robert Smith, the President of the Corporation.

Q. Was he President of the Respondent Corporation at that time?

A. Yes sir.

Q. When were these materials to be -- Were these materials to be furnished for the three dwellings, one of which was to be erected on Lot 81,

one on Lot 82 and one on Lot 170, all on Boykin Boulevard of Lillian Beach Sub-division as per plat thereof as recorded in Map Book 3, pages 78-79, in the Probate Records of Baldwin County, Alabama? ---My question was: Were the materials furnished for the houses erected on those lots?

A. That is right.

Q. I will show you Exhibits A., B., and C. to our bill of complaint. What do those exhibits reflect?

A. Exhibit A. is a list of materials furnished for the house being erected on Lot 81.

Q. Were the materials that are listed there furnished and used in the erection of such house?

A. They were.

Q. Is the price that is set out there the fair and reasonable market value of the materials?

A. In my opinion it is more than fair.

Q. Did the Respondent Corporation agree to pay the price for the materials as set out in each of the three exhibits?

A. They did.

Q. Now look at Exhibit B. I believe you state that each of these were the fair and reasonable market price?

A. Yes sir.

Q. And the materials shown by each of these exhibits were furnished and went into the houses?

A. They did.

Q. On Exhibit B., which house did that go into?

A. The house on Lot 82.

Q. Exhibit C., which lot was that?

A. That is Lot 170 on Boykin Boulevard.

Q. Did your Corporation file liens in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, as shown by Exhibits D., E. and F.?

A. We did.

Q. Are those true and correct copies of the liens that were filed in the office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama?

A. They are.

Q. Do you know the date those liens were filed in the office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama ?

A. To the best of my knowledge it was November 27th or 28th. of 1956.

Q. Was that within six months of the time the materials were furnished?

A. It was, yes sir.

Q. Now how much was the total indebtedness for the materials which were furnished, which we referred to that were furnished as described in these Exhibits? What was the total indebtedness?

A. \$2,994.01.

Q. Now what was the due date of the last materials furnished on that

indebtedness ?

A. You mean what was the date we furnished the last material?

Q. Right?

A. June 22, 1956.

Q. Now how much interest would have accrued at 6% since June 22, 1956, on this indebtedness?

A. \$164.67.

Q. Adding the interest to the indebtedness, what would be the total amount due on the indebtedness?

A. \$3,158.68. I figured that on the total amount rather than breaking each one down individually, so there might be a slight discrepancy.

Q. Since we have asked for a lien on each of the three lots, I believe you stated that the indebtedness due on the materials which went into the house on Lot 81 would be \$459.43. When you add 6% interest from the date of furnishing the last materials, to date, how much would be due under that lien?

A. \$484.62.

Q. How much would be due for the materials furnished for the house on Lot 82, including interest to date?

A. Since the last material was furnished?

Q. Yes?

A. \$2,140.

Q. How much would be due on the building for the materials furnished for the building that was erected on Lot 170, including interest to date?

A. \$533.95.

Q I believe you stated that no part of any of these amounts have been paid?

A. No part has been paid, No sir.


