This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confession Waiver and Answer and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Laura W. Crider is forever divorced from the said Ike Crider for and on account of

Abandonment; it is further ordered that the care, custody and control of the minor child of said marriage, Pamela Lynn Crider, is awarded to Laura W. Crider, subject to the right of Ike Crider to visit said child at reasonable hours and places during vacation periods; the agreement of parties attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is approved and both parties are further ordered to abide by the terms of said agreement which is incorporated in this decree. Complainant may resume the use of her maiden name.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Laura W. Crider the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

EXHIBIT "A"

AGREEMENT OF PARTIES

Whereas Laura W. Crider, wife, and Ike Crider, husband, have experienced various disputes and unhappy differences between them, and they are separated and are not now living together as husband and wife; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties hereto to make a complete and final settlement of all their property, now owned by the parties hereto, and hereafter acquired, and to settle and adjust all marital interests: now, therefore, it is mutually agreed as follows:

I.

The wife shall have the care, custody and control of the minor child, Pamela Lynn Crider. The husband shall have the right to visit the said child at reasonable places and hours during vacation periods.

II.

The husband concurrently herewith agrees to and does hereby transfer and convey to the wife as her separate property, all of the following property: one cedar chest, and personal clothing and effects.

III.

The wife agrees to and does hereby remise, release and transfer to the husband as his sole and separate property that certain 1955 Oldsmobile automobile, motor number Y 799138 and one suit of bedroom furniture.

IV.

It is further agreed that any and all property acquired by either party subsequent to the date of this agreement shall be the separate property of the party acquiring the same; and each party hereto agrees, one with the other, that should it become necessary in the future, in order to effect the sale or transfer of any property, real or personal, belonging to either of the parties, either party will sign for the other, promptly, any and all papers necessary or requisite to complete such transaction.

V.

It is further understood and agreed that the terms and provisions of this agreement may be incorporated in any decree of divorce which may be hereafter obtained by either party, and enforceable by contempt proceedings if necessary.

VI.

It is specifically agreed and understood between the parties hereto that in consideration of various sums of money given to the wife by the husband, and in further consideration of the covenants contained herein, that this agreement shall constitute the entire property settlement between these parties and that no further alimony, support or maintenance shall be

due or shall grow due between these parties.

and represents unto this Honorable Court as follows:


1. That your Complainant is over the age of twenty-one
