SOCIAL SUMMARY

Mary Edwards and her six children have been receiving Aid to Dependent Children through the Department of Pensions and Security since 1953, when her husband deserted her. The grant which she receives from this department is not enough to meet the needs of this family. If it were not for George Preston, who is badly afflicted, Mary could more than likely make a decent living for herself and children. Mary has had two years in college and could teach or get a job at Brookly Air Force Base, which is not far from her home. However, George, according to a local physician, is insane and should really be in an institution. Efforts have been made to place George in the State School for mentally ill, but due to crowded conditions he has not been accepted, and no hope has been given of his being accepted in the near future.

George at this time is six years old. He is not toilet trained, wears diapers, and has to be watched day and night, as he seems to be a sexual problem and pushes and shoves the other children around.

Mary and the children live in a shack belonging to Mary's mother and father. Her mother and father are both old and they are not able to help Mary and the children in any way except to offer them the place to live.

Mary and the children have no income other than what they receive through the Department of Pensions and Security.
