
PRAYER FOR PROCESS

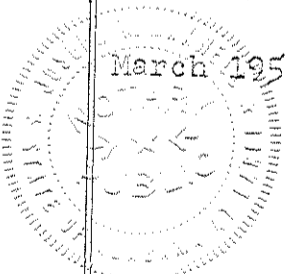
