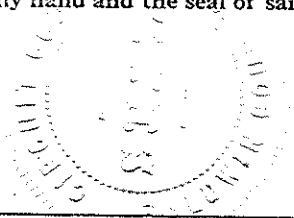

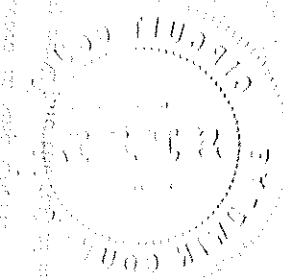

testified as follows:

My names is Elizabeth Moorer, I am the Complainant in the above styled cause. I am a resident of Bay Minette Baldwin County,

County, Alabama and have been for more than three years next before the filing of this bill and over 21 years of age.

Respondent I.W.Moorer is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and is over 21 years of age.

Respondent and I.W.Moorer and myself are husband and wife, We were married at or near Farmersville in Lowndes County about January 1881, We lived together as man and wife until to wit: May 1922.

In May 1922, more than 2 years ago the said I.W.Moorer, voluntarily abandoned my bed and board and has since that time remained away

voluntarily and continuously. We were living at Bay Minette, Baldwin County Alabama at the time he went away.

During the whole time we lived together as man and wife, I at no time gave the said I.W.Moorer, any excuse for going away, but was always a dutiful and obedient wife.

The said I.W.Moorer went away of his own accord, and has remained away continuously since the above date of his own accord and without any cause from me.

William H. Moorer a witness for Complainant who being duly sworn  
testified as follows:  
My name is William H. Moorer, I am a son of I.W. Moorer and Elizabeth Moorer, I was living in the home with my father and Mother at the time he went away and had been living with them all my life up to that time, I.W. Moorer went away in May 1922, so far as I know voluntarily, and has remained away continuously ever since. I am living about 50 yds from where my Mother Mrs. Moorer now lives and know that I.W. Moorer has remained away from my mother since he went away in May 1922.  
I did not at any time hear my mother give the said I.W. Moorer any excuse for leaving my mother and he did not at any time complain that my mother mistreated him in any way or give him any excuse cause for leaving her. My mother Mrs Elizabeth Moorer and the said I.W. Moorer has not lived together as man and wife since he went away in 1922.
