My name is Vivian Dee Veach. I am 17 years of age and I live with my father and mother in Pensacola, Florida. On February 7, 1957 I had a date with Joseph C. Phillippi, the Respondent in this case. That afternoon we left Pensacola and drove to Lucedale, Mississippi with Dave Donnellon, where we got a marriage license. We were married before a Justice of the Peace whose name I do not remember. Then we started back toward Foley, Alabama and Pensacola. While we were on the way back Joseph Phillippi and Dave Donnellon his friend began to laugh and talk about the wedding and to make fun of it. Joseph Phillippi said to me that he had been married before and that he had a child by that marriage and that he did not love me. That after considering what he had done and how serious marriage was that he would not live with me and go through life with me as husband and wife. He told me that he had acted with poor judgement and without thought to the consequences and that we could not live together. We went on to Pensacola and he left me at my father's house and left to go where he lived in Foley, Alabama. I have not seen him since that night except for two occasions when I talked with him in my father's presences. We have never lived together as husband and wife, have never had an intercourse and have never cohabited with each other.

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN
COUNTY, ALABAMA IN SITTING EQUITY:

Comes now the Complainant, Vivian D. Veach by her father and next
friend Carl Lester Veach and relates as follows:

I

That Complainant is a resident of Pensacola, Florida and is a minor
of the age of 17 years; that Carl Lester Veach is a resident of Pensacola,
Florida and is over the age of 21 years; that Joseph C. Phillippi is a resident
of Baldwin County, Alabama and is over the age of 21 years.

II

That on, to-wit, February 7, 1957 Complainant and Respondent left
Complainant's home in Pensacola, Florida in Respondent's automobile and drove
to Lucedale, Mississippi. There they obtained a marriage license and were
joined together as husband and wife in a ceremony performed by a Justice of
the Peace they immediately thereafter started back in Respondent's automobile
to Pensacola. Before they reached Mobile Respondent stated to Complainant
that he had acted with poor judgement and without thought to the consequences,
that he had been married before and that he had a child by the former marriage,
that he could not and would not carry out his martial vows and that he did
not love her enough to go through life with her as husband and wife. They
continued on their journey to Pensacola where he carried her to her father's
home and informed him of the marriage ceremony. Respondent then left for his
home in Baldwin County, Alabama. Complainant and Respondent had no inter-
course, never cohabited with each other and, except for appearing before the
Justice of the Peace in Lucedale, Mississippi, have never acted as husband
and wife nor lived together as husband and wife. They have not seen each
other since the time of the marriage ceremony except for two short periods in
the presence of Complainant's parents. Complainant was at the time of
marriage ready and willing to inter into the marriage relation.

Complainant did not know of Respondent's prior marriage nor of his
child.

NOW THEREFORE, the premises considered, Complainant prays that Joseph C. Phillippi be made party respondent to this complaint, that a summons be issued to him requiring him to plead, answer or demur to this bill of complaint within the time described by law and the practice of this Honorable Court and that upon a final hearing Your Honor will grant unto the Complainant a degree annulling and declaring null and void the purported marriage between the Complainant and Respondent; and restoring to Complainant her maiden name of Veach; and Complainant further prays that Your Honor will grant such other, further, different or general relief to which Complainant may be in equity and good conscience entitled.
