DECREE AND ORDER REMOVING DISABILITIES OF
NON-AGE ON PETITION OF OUIDA S. BERGLIN

This cause now coming on to be heard is submitted for a final decree upon the verified petition, notices and affidavits as shown by a note of submission; and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion and finds that the allegations of the petition are true, that the petitioner, Ouida S. Berglin, is the mother of Robert S. Berglin, a minor, that Lavigne A. Berglin, Sr., the father of said minor is dead, that said minor has no legal guardian, and that said minor resides with his said mother in the County of Baldwin, Alabama, that said minor is over the age of eighteen (18) years and will not attain the age of twenty-one (21) years until April 20, 1959, that said minor is for his age a person of mature judgment and has had some experience in business matters and is competent and capable in every way of handling his own affairs and is fully capable of transacting his business affairs; and that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and the Court further finds that it is to the best interest of such minor to grant the prayer of said petition;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court:

1. That the said Robert S. Berglin be and he hereby is completely and unconditionally relieved of the disabilities of non-age and is now vested with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate and other property, and in general to do and perform all acts which he could lawfully do if he were over the

age of twenty-one (21) years.

2. That the said Robert S. Berglin file a copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama and in each of the counties in which said minor shall hereafter reside, and in the office of the Judge of Probate in each county in the said state where said minor shall do any business or make any contracts;

3. That the petitioner pay the cost of this proceeding for which execution may issue.



PETITION FOR RELIEVING OF DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your Petitioner, the undersigned, Ouida S. Berglin, respectfully shows unto this Honorable Court and avers as follows:

1. That your Petitioner is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
2. That your Petitioner is the mother of Robert S. Berglin, a minor, being over the age of eighteen years; that Lavigne A. Berglin, the father of said minor, Robert S. Berglin, is dead; that said minor has no legal guardian; and that said minor resides with your Petitioner in the said County of Baldwin, Alabama.
3. That the said Robert S. Berglin is over the age of eighteen years and will not attain the age of twenty-one years until April 20, 1959. That said minor is now attending college, is well educated for his years, is of sound mind and good judgment, has had some experience with business affairs and is fully capable of transacting his business affairs, and that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE your Petitioner respectfully prays that this Honorable Court will set this petition down for a date to be heard and will direct the issuance of proper notice as required by law to the said Robert S. Berglin of the disabilities of non-age; and that this Honorable Court will make all such orders and decrees in the premises as to it may seem just and proper and will grant such other, further and different relief as the Court deems proper, the premises considered.

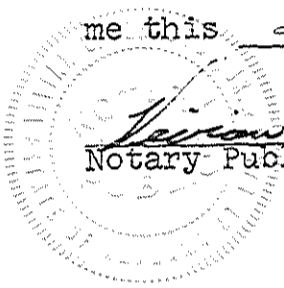

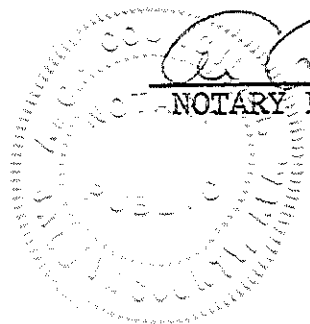
