It is further ordered that Charlie Leon Baggett the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

That my name is Charlie Leon Baggett, I am over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been all my life. The Respondent, Clara Mae Bagget is over the age of 21 and has been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama more than two years next preceding. We were married at Lucedale, Mississippi, on August 7, 1955 and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama until August 29, 1955 at which time the Respondent abandoned me without fault on my part. We have not lived together since that time as husband and wife and there are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I do not believe we will ever live together again as husband and wife and respectfully ask for my divorce.

I do not believe they will ever live together again as husband and wife.

3.


