I am a bona-fide resident citizen of the State of Alabama and i have been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint herein. The Respondent is a resident of There are two minor children as issue of our marriage, William Burman Atchison, age sixteen years and Mary Virginia Atchison, age fifteen years. Said children live and reside with me at 256 S. Royal Street, Mobile, Alabama, and I am a fit and proper person to be granted their custody and control. Respondent voluntarily abaondoned my bed and board for more than one year next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint herein. The Respondent and I were living at 1828 Richardson Avenue, Dallas, Texas when she left me. She told me that she did nt care for me anymore that she wanted to be free to go with whom she pleased, and that she wasn't going to live with me again and she left.
