TO THE HONORABLE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY, AND TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE THEREOF:

Comes your petitioner, the undersigned Murray R. Bryant, Sr., and respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and unto this Honorable Court as follows:

### FIRST:

That he is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Stockton, Baldwin County, Alabama.

#### SECOND:

The he is the father of Murray R. Bryant, Jr., a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years and that said minor resides with the petitioner in Stockton, Baldwin County, Alabama. That your petitioner is not the guardian of his son and there is no guardianship over said minor or his estate.

#### THIRD:

That the said Murray R. Bryant, Jr. owns property consisting of interests in personal property in Baldwin County, Alabama; and
is a person of mature judgment and of sober and industrious habits
and he is fully competent and capable in every way of handling his
own affairs as if he were of age, and that it will be to the best
interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your petitioner prays this this Honorable Court will set a date for the hearing of this petition and will cause notice of the filing of this petition and the day set for the hearing hereof to be given to the said Murray R. Bryant, Jr. by service of a copy of this petition on said minor by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and that upon the hearing of this petition that this Honorable Court will decree that the said Murray R. Bryant, Jr. be relieved unconditionally from the disabilities of non-age and that in and by the terms of said decree that this Honorable Court will vest the said Murray R. Bryant, Jr. with the

right to sue and be sued, contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age.

## FINAL DECREE:

This being the day set by an order of this Court entered upon the 15th day of June, 1957, to hear the sworn petition of Murray R. Bryant, Sr. to remove the disabilities of non-age of his minor son, Murray R. Bryant, Jr., a copy of such petition and of said notice having been duly served upon said minor by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and said proceeding now being submitted upon such sworn petition and upon the affidavits of Randolph McGowan, Jr. and Ruth Cox Young, and after consideration thereof the Court is satisfied that it is to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the petition be granted and that Murray R. Bryant, Jr., be, and he hereby is, relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and is vested with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all the acts which he could lawfully do if he were of the full age of twenty-one years.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Murray R. Bryant, Jr., file a certified copy of this decree in the Office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama, and a certified copy hereof in the Office of the Probate Judge of each other County in this State in which he may hereafter reside, or in which he may do any business or make any contracts.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Murray R. Bryant, Sr. pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
