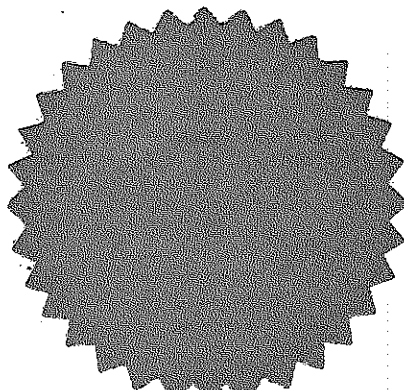
It is further ordered that Florence Hinote be, and she is hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.



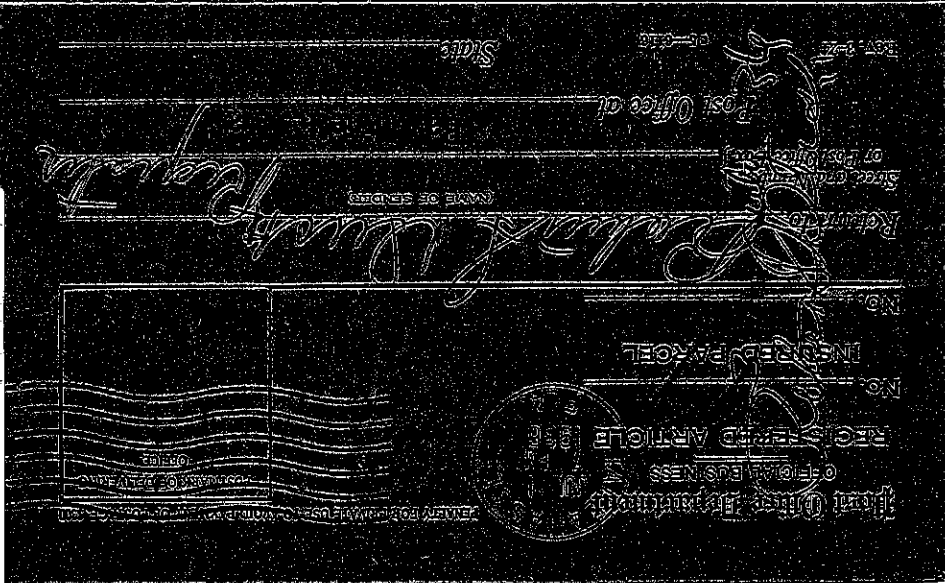
