It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Johnny B. Hayes the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

That my name is Macie McCorry Hayes, I am over the age of 21 and have been a resident of the State of Alabama more than two years next preceeding. The Respondent, Johnny B. Hayes, is also over the age of 21 and is a bona fide resident of the State of Alabama. We were married on April 16, 1957 at Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama until on or about June 8, 1957 at which time I was forced to leave the Respondent because he came in and threatened my life or health striking me about the head and body so that I became in fear of my life or health and have not lived with him as his wife since that day. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.

That my name is Shirley Owens, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and both have resided in Baldwin County, Alabama more than two years next preceeding. They were married on April 16, 1957 at Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County until their separation on Saturday night June 8th at which time the Respondent came home and began to abuse the Complainant threatening her and striking her about the body so that she became in fear of her life or health and she has never lived together with him as his wife since that occasion and I do not believe they will ever live together anymore. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.


