It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said ADA JEANETTE ROLIN is forever divorced from the said GILBERT HERMAN ROLIN for and on account of CRUELTY

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the complainant may resume her maiden name of Ada Jeanette Sutton;

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Ada Jeanette Rolin the complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

witnesses named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 21 day of June 1957, at the office of Beebe & Swearingen in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness<sup>es</sup> to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Ada Jeanette Rolin and Carlie Sutton doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Ada Jeanette Sutton. I am complainant in that certain cause pending in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, against Gilbert Herman Rolin. I am 17 years of age and he is 18 years of age. We both reside at Bay Minette where we have resided for several years next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint for divorce. We are husband and wife. We married at Bay Minette on November 30, 1956, and lived together in Bay Minette as husband and wife until June 18, when we separated. The cause of our separation was his cruelty and abuse. Within a few weeks after our marriage he beat me unmercifully with his fists and on several occasions since then he has cursed and abused me. On Saturday June 15th, about 6:30 P. M. without just cause he took me out in the woods North of Bay Minette and beat me unmercifully with his fists, choked me and caused severe bruises on my face, hands and body. He then took me back home, locked me in the house and kept me there against my will. He threatened that if I left he would kill me. On Tuesday morning, June 18th he again became angered at me and threatened to beat me and told me that when he came home he was going to beat me again. While he was away I left and went to my parents home. He is a man of violent and ungovernable temper and I feared that should I continue to live with him he would do me bodily harm attendant with danger to my life and health. We have no children and will have none. I desire to resume my maiden name, Ada Jeanette Sutton.

Ada Jeanette Rolin

My name is Carlie Sutton. I am the mother of Ada Jeanette Rolin. On Monday June 17, I saw Jeanette and her body and face and arms were bruised from the beating Gilbert Herman Rolin gave her the Saturday before. This was the first I had known that he had ever been cruel to her and struck her. From her condition on Monday following the beating he gave her on Saturday it would be dangerous for her to continue to live with him. His cruelty and conduct is such that should she live with him he probably would do her bodily harm attendant with danger to her life and health.

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY:

Now comes your complainant, Ada Jeanette Rolin, and humbly complaining against the defendant, Gilbert Herman Rolin, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

FIRST: That your complainant is 17 years of age, that the defendant, Gilbert Herman Rolin is 18 years of age, and that they are both residents of Bay Minette in Baldwin County, Alabama, where they have resided for more than twelve months next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint.

SECOND: That they were married in Bay Minette, Alabama on November 30, 1956 and lived together as husband and wife in Bay Minette until June 18, 1957, when your complainant because of the

cruelty of the defendant was compelled to leave the defendant, that there were no children born to complainant and defendant.

THIRD: That the defendant is a man of violent and un-governable temper and without just cause or excuse has frequently become enraged and has beat complainant unmercifully with his fist and with his belt buckle and is growing worse and she fears that should she return to him he would inflict bodily injury upon her attendant with danger to her life or health. That on Saturday, June 15th, he took her out about 6:30 P.M. in the evening out in the woods North of Bay Minette and unmercifully beat her and for no reason other than she did not want to go to his parents home; that he took her back home and kept her locked in the house all night; that on Tuesday morning he again became enraged without just cause or reasonable excuse abused complainant and threatened to kill her; that while he was away she on that day, fearing that upon his return that he would exercise his threats to kill her, went to the home of her parents where she has remained since.

WHEREFORE your complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause and by appropriate process make the said Gilbert Herman Rolin party defendant hereto and require him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between this complainant and the said defendant; and complainant prays for such other, further or different relief as in equity and good conscience she shall be entitled to receive in the premises.
