It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Emilee Thompson Wilson is forever divorced from the said Leonie L. Wilson for and on account of Cruelty.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the Complainant, Emilee Thompson Wilson, shall resume the use of her maiden name, Emilee Thompson.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Leonie L. Wilson the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

LeNoir Thompson in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness as to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Eunice Thompson Wilson and Leona Thompson doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Eunice Thompson Wilson, I am over the age of 21 and have been a resident of Alabama all my life. The Respondent Lonnie L. Wilson is over the age of 21 and is presently a resident of Alabama. We married on January 11, 1954 at Pascagoula, Mississippi and lived together in Alabama as husband and wife until on or about Saturday March 16, 1957 at which time our separation occurred. The cause of the separation being that we had been having difficulties for some time and on that evening the respondent threatened me and losing his temper struck me without fault on my part so that I became in fear of my life or health and I left him. We have not lived together as husband and wife since that occasion. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and a property settlement has been made between the parties. I know that I will never live with the Respondent anymore as his wife and respectfully ask that I be granted a divorce and the right to resume the use of my maiden name which is Laura Eunice Thompson.

Eunice Thompson Wilson

That my name is Leona Thompson, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and the Complainant has been a resident of Baldwin County, all her life. The Respondent has lived in Alabama since the marriage and is presently residing in Alabama. They were married in Pascagoula, Mississippi on January 11, 1954 and lived together as husband and wife until on or about March 16, 1957. They have not lived together as husband and wife since that occasion. The cause of the separation was a difficulty which happened on the night of March 16th when the Complainant came home to me in fear of her life or health from the treatment given her by the Respondent. I know they will never live together again as husband and wife. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and they have made a property settlement between them.



The Respondent admits the allegations as to ages, marriage and residence, but denies all other allegations contained in the bill of complaint, and demands strict proof of the same.


