



TO THE HONORABLE H. M. HALL JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, Sitting in Equity:-

Comes your Complainant, Raymond C. Styron, and files this his Bill of Complaint for divorce against Ilene Styron, and respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor:

1. That the Complainant is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident citizen of the State of Alabama, Baldwin County.

2. That the Complainant and the Respondent were lawfully married on, to-wit, June 28, 1947.

3. Complainant further avers that the Respondent has committed actual violence on his person attended with danger to his life and health and from her conduct toward him, he is reasonably apprehensive of other and further actual violence to his person attended with danger to his life or health, so much so that he can no longer live with the Respondent.

4. Complainant further shows unto the Court that there has been born of this marriage one child, namely Mary Styron, who is eight years of age, and who is now in the custody and control of the Complainant.

5. The Complainant further shows unto the Court that an agreement has been reached between the parties hereto whereby the Complainant shall pay to the Respondent the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), payable in an amount not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month, as and for, full settlement for any and all claims for alimony or support, the first payment to be made thirty days from date of divorce decree, followed by successive payments of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) every thirty days until the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) has been paid.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays that Ilene Styron be made a party defendant of this cause by the usual process by personal service, of this Honorable Court, requiring her to plead, answer, or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause that he be granted a divorce from the said Respondent, and that Complainant be granted the custody and control of Mary Styron, the minor child of this marriage with rights of visitation with the Respondent every other week-end, beginning Friday night through Sunday, and that Respondent be awarded the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), to be paid by the Complainant at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month, as and for, full settlement for any and all claims for alimony or support, the first payment to be made thirty days from date of divorce decree, followed by successive payments of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) every thirty days until the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) has been paid. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that he be granted such other, further and different and general relief to which he may be entitled and as in duty bound he will ever pray.

Testimony of Raymond C. Styron:

My name is Raymond C. Styron. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, having been such a resident citizen all of my life. Ilene Styron is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were married on June 28, 1947, and lived together as husband and wife until May 26, 1958, except that the last several years there have been a number of temporary separations, the last being since January of 1958. On May 26, 1958, Ilene Styron committed actual violence on my person by striking me on the head with a metal box, by striking me with her fist and by clawing me with her finger nails, all resulting in injury and in danger to my life or health. From her conduct toward me I am reasonably sure that should we continue to live together she will commit other and further actual physical violence on my person attended with danger to my life or health. There is one child of this marriage, Mary Styron, 8 years of age, who is in my care and custody. I believe it proper that she should so continue, however, have at this time no objection to Ilene Styron having reasonable rights of visitation, and believe it will be to the best interest of the child at this time to visit the said Ilene Styron from Friday evening to Sunday evening every other week-end, and suggest the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month as being the proper time. I believe that I am financially able to pay to Ilene Styron \$1,000.00 in an amount not less than \$50.00 per month, without interest.
