Testimony of Raymond C. Styron:

My name is Raymond C. Styron. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, having been such a resident citizen all of my life. Ilene Styron is over the age of twentyone years and is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were one years and is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were married on June 28, 1947, and lived together as husband and wife until May 26, 1958, except that the last several years there have been a number of temporary separations, the last being since January of 1958. I believe it proper that she should so continue, however, have at this time no objection to Ilene Styron having reasonable rights of visitation, and believe it will be to the best interest of the child at this time to visit the said Ilene Styron from Friday evening to Sunday evening every other week-end, and suggest the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month as being the proper time. I believe that I am financially able to pay to Ilene Styron \$1,000.00 in an amount not less than \$50.00 per month, without interest.
