TO: THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE THEREOF:

Comes your Petitioner, the undersigned Ida Belle Jones, and respectfully represents and shows unto Your Honor and unto this Honorable Court as follows:

FIRST:

That she is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing near Perdido.

SECOND:

That she is the mother of Janice Ardis, a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years and that said minor resides with the Petitioner near Perdido, Baldwin County, Alabama. That your Petitioner is not the guardian of her daughter and there is no guardianship over said minor or her estate.

THIRD:

That the said Janice Ardis owns an interest in real property in Baldwin County, Alabama; and is a person of mature judgment and of sober and industrious habits and she is fully competent and capable in every way of handling her own affairs as if she were of age, and that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Petitioner prays that this Honorable Court will set a date for the hearing of this petition and will cause notice of the filing of this petition and the day set for the hearing thereof to be given to the said Janice Ardis by service of a copy of this petition on said minor by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and that upon the hearing of this petition that this Honorable Court will decree that the said Janice Ardis be relieved unconditionally from the disabilities of non-age and that in and by the terms of said decree that this Honor-

able Court will vest the said Janice Ardis with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if she was twenty-one years of age.

FINAL DECREE:

This being the day set by an order of this Court entered upon the 25th day of June, 1958, to hear the sworn petition of Ida Belle Jones to remove the disabilities of non-age of her minor daughter, Janice Ardis, a copy of such petition and of said notice having been duly served upon said minor by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and said proceeding now being submitted upon such sworn petition and upon the affidavits of Marshall P. Brown and W. E. Dean, and after consideration thereof, the Court is satisfied that it is to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the petition be granted and that Janice Ardis be, and she hereby is, relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and is vested with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all the acts which she could lawfully do if she were of the full age of twenty-one years.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Janice Ardis file a certified copy of this decree in the Office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama, and a certified copy hereof in the Office of the Probate Judge of each other County in this State in which she may hereafter reside, or in which she may do any business or make any contracts.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Janice Ardis pay the cost of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
