MOTION TO MODIFY DECREE

That on to-wit, July 21, 1958, Your Honor made and entered a decree divorcing Respondent and Complainant, giving Complainant custody of their infant child, Patricia Ann Hurlbert and ordering Respondent to pay \$15.00 per maxxx support for the said child.

BILL OF COMPLAINT

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY:

Your Complainant LOIS NORMA HURLBERT, respectfully shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

Ι

That your Complainant is over the age of twenty-one years, and is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the Respondent Harvey Arnold Hurlbert, is over the age of twenty-one years and is now living at 5759 South Craft Highway, Prichard, Alabama.

II

That the Complainant and the Respondent were married at Lucedale, Mississippi on the 30th day of November, 1945 and have lived together as husband and wife in Fairhope, Alabama, until on to-wit: the 24th day of June, 1958.

III

That on June the 24th, 1958, and on various occasions prior thereto, the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant by slapping her in the face and about the head, which would necessarily endanger her life and health; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give your Complainant every reasonable apprenhension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with the Respondent that he would continue to do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

IV

That there was born to the marriage between the Complainant and the Respondent, a child Patricia Ann Hurlbert, age five (5),

who is now and has been all of her life, living with her mother, the Complainant; that your Complainant is a suitable, fit and proper person to have her care, custody and control.

V

That your Complainant has no seperate estate or funds out of which to provide for the support of the said minor child; that the Respondent is an able bodied man capable of supporting the said minor child. That the Respondent is now working and averages around Sixty to Seventy Dollars per week in salary.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that the Respondent Harvey Arnold Hurlbert, be made a party Respondent to this cause by the usual writ of process of this Honorable Court requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this court and under the statutes and such cases made and provided.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, that your Honor will grant unto your Complainant and absolute divorce from said Respondent.

Complainant further prays that she be awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the said minor child, Patricia Ann Hurlbert; that the court will make all necessary orders and decrees as may be proper, fixing a sufficient amount of money to be paid by the Respondent, to the Complainant for the support of the said minor child; and order the Respondent to pay the same.

Complainant prays for all such other further and different relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
