- 1. The Complainant is not a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. The Respondent is not a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

- 8. The Complainant and the Respondent were not residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, when the alleged separation occurred.

Comes your Complainant, Jo Anne Bain, and files this her Bill of Complaint for divorce against Euel Richard Bain, Jr., and shows unto Your Honor and unto this Honorable Court as follows:

FIRST:

That your Complainant and the Respondent are both over the age of twenty-one years and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing in Fairhope, Alabama.

SECOND:

That your Complainant and the Respondent were married on, heretofore, to-wit, March 2\frac{1}{2}, 1951 in Gulfport, Mississippi, and live together as husband and wife until on, to-wit, July 12, 1958, when, on
account of the matters hereinafter complained of, your Complainant
was compelled to live separate and apart from the Respondent; that
your Complainant avers that the Respondent has, since her said marriage to Respondent, become addicted to habitual drunkeness and that
the said habit has continued to the filing of this Bill; Complainant
avers and charges that Respondent has made numerous threats of doing

her physical harm and from his manner and conduct toward her, she is reasonably convinced that he will commit an actual violence on her person, attended with danger to her life and health.

THIRD:

That there was born of the marriage between Complainant and Respondent the following named child: Debbie Anne Bain, aged two and one-half years and the Complainant has a minor child, Joe Morris Bain, aged nine years, which child was duly adopted by the Respondent. That your Complainant is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of the said minor children.

FOURTH:

That your Complainant and the Respondent joining own certain personal property, consisting of the sum of, to-wit, Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), household furnishings and one 1955 Plymouth automobile. That your Complainant has no money or property with which to properly support and educate the said minor children and the Respondent is able to pay your Complainant sufficient amounts to properly support and educate said children. That your Complainant has employed Ernest M. Bailey as her Solicitor of Record to prosecute this cause of action and she is unable to pay him a reasonable Solicitor's fee for his services in this matter.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF:

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that the above named Euel Richard Bain, Jr. be made a party Defendant to this cause by the usual writ or process of this Honorable Court requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause Your Honor will award the Complainant custody and control of the said minor children herein named and, if he deems necessary, will order a reference to determine such support as may be necessary as and for support of said minor children and to determine the interest of your Complainant in and to the said personal property jointly owned by the Complainant and Respondent. That Your Honor will also order and decree that the Respondent be required to pay Ernest M. Bailey a reasonable Solicitor's fee for his services in prosecuting this cause;

that Your Honor will also grant unto Complainant an absolute divorce from the Respondent and decree that the parties be allowed to remarry if they see fit. Should Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to her such other, further and different relief as in duty bound she will ever pray.
