C O M P L A I N T

The Complaint of GERTRUDE KIRKHAM HALL respectfully shows:

I. That plaintiff is a resident and citizen of the County of Volusia, State of Florida, and is at present residing at 803 - 24th Street, New Smyrna Beach, Florida

II. That plaintiff is the (former) wife of JACK S. M. HALL, the defendant; that plaintiff was duly married to said defendant on the 24th day of August, 1937, in the City of Seattle State of Washington

III. That plaintiff is the mother of and the defendant is the father of the following named children, to-wit: (give names and birth dates)

Henrietta Ida Hall, born May 18, 1942

IV.
