Comes now your Complainant, Kay Owen Ganey and shows whto your Honor as follows:

I

That she is over the age of 21 years and is a bona fide resident of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama and that Howard Ganey, Respondent, is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama.

II

That on October 31, 1954 Complainant and Respondent went through a marriage ceremony before a Justice of the Peace in Pascagoula, Mississippi and that they lived together as husband and wife from that date until August 20, 1958. That at the time of the said marriage Respondent represented to Complainant that he had been married and divorced some time prior to October 31, 1954 and that Complainant believed that Respondent was free to marry.

III

That subsequent to the said marriage to-wit: August 20, 1958 Complainant discovered that on October 31, 1954 Respondent was still married and that he was not divorced from his former wife and that as a consequence he was not free to marry; that she left the bed and board of Respondent and has not lived with him since that time.

Now therefore, Complainant prays that Respondent, Howard Ganey be made party Respondent to this complaint, that he be required to answer, plead or demur to same within the time required by law and the practice of this Court and that, upon a final hearing of this cause Your Honor will make and enter a decree declaring the bonds of matrimony supposed to exist between Complainant and Respondent null, void and to no effect, and Complainant prays for such other further and different relief to which she may be in good conscience and equity entitled.
