This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ on X Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Ollie Bailey Jemison is forever divorced from the said Willie Edward Jemison for and on account of Abandonment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED, That the Complainant, Ollie Bailey Jemison, shall have the care, custody and control of the minor children, Willie Edward Jemison Jr., age 5 yrs., and Cornelius Orlando Jemison, age 4 yrs.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED, That the Respondent, Willie Edward Jemison, shall pay to the Complainant, Ollie Bailey Jemison the sum of \$77.10 per month as maintenance and support for the minor children, Willie Edward Jemison Jr., age 5 years and Cornelius Orlando Jemison, age 4 years.

It is futher ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is futher ordered that Ollie Bailey Jemison the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

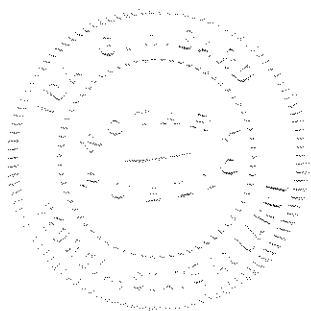

LeNoir Thompson in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness es to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Ollie Bailey Jemison and Louvenia Bailey doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Ollie Bailey Jemison, I am over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been more than two years next preceeding. The Respondent is also over the age of 21 and a resident of the State of Alabama and has been more than 2 years next preceding, though he is temporarily in the Armed Services. We were married in Birmingham, Alabama on October 2, 1945 and lived together as husband and wife until on or about June 14, 1957 at which time the respondent abandoned me without fault on my part. There was born as fruits of our marriage two children Willie Edward Jemison, Jr., age about 5 and Cornelius Orlando Jemison, age about 4. I have had the care, custody and control of these children since birth and respectfully represent to this Honorable Court that I am a fit, suitable and proper person to have their permanent care, custody and control. I respectfully suggest that the sum of \$77.10 is a reasonable amount for the maintenance and support of these children and ask that the respondent be ordered to pay this amount. I do not ever expect to live with the respondent again as his wife.

Ollie Bailey Jemison

That my name is Louvenia Bailey. I know both parties to this cause. They are both over the age of 21 and are residents of the State of Alabama and have been more than two years next preceding. They were married on or about October 2, 1945 in Birmingham, Alabama and lived together as husband and wife until on or about the 14th of June 1957 at which time the respondent abandoned the complainant without fault on her part. Two children were born as fruits of this marriage, being, Willie Edward Jemison, Jr., age about 5, and Cornelius Orlando Jemison, age about 4. The Complainant has had the care, custody and control of these children since birth and I recommend her as being a fit, suitable and proper person to have their permanent care, custody and control. I do not believe these parties will ever live together again as husband and wife.


4.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Willie Edward Jemison, party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that a decree be made granting her the sum of Seventy-seven & 10/100 (\$77.10) Dollars per month to be paid by the Respondent, Willie Edward Jemison, for the maintenance and support of the minor children, Willie Edward Jemison Jr., age about 5 years and Cornelius Orlando Jemison, age about 4 years, and your Petitioner does not ask for any maintenance and support for herself; that a decree be made awarding to the Complainant the care, custody and control of the minor children, Willie Edward Jemison Jr., age about 5 years and Cornelius Orlando Jemison, age about 4 years; Your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
