TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your Petitioner, the undersigned, respectfully shows unto this Honorable Court and avers:

1.

That she is over the age of 21 years, and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2.

That she is the mother of William Howard Huggins, a minor over the age of 18 years; that John L. Huggins, the father of the said minor, William Howard Huggins is dead, and that the said minor has no legal guardian; and that the said minor resides with your petitioner in said county of Baldwin.

3.

That the said William Howard Huggins, is over the age of 18 years, and will not obtain the age of 21 years until December 19, 1960. That said minor owns no property in the said county but that he is well educated for his years, is of sound mind and good judgment, has had some experience with business affairs and is fully capable of transacting his own business affairs, and that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.
