IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Petitioner pay the cost incurred in this proceeding, for which execution may issue.

Comes your Petitioner, the undersigned, George Thomas Till-
man, and respectfully represents and shows unto Your Honor and
unto this Honorable Court as follows:

That he is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resi-

lieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Petitioner prays
that this Honorable Court will set a date for the hearing of
this petition and will cause notice of the filing of this pe-
tition and the day set for the hearing thereof to be given to the
said George Roderick Tillman by service of a copy of this peti-
tion on said minor by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and
that upon the hearing of this petition that this Honorable Court

will decree that the said George Roderick Tillman be relieved unconditionally from the disabilities of non-age and that in and by the terms of said decree that this Honorable Court will vest the said George Roderick Tillman with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey both real and personal property and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.
