ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the prayer of the said Petitioner be granted, and that the said Hazel Gleniece Boykin, a minor, be relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and that she be granted the right to transact her own business; to contract and be contracted with; to sue and be sued; to sell and buy real estate; and generally to do and perform all acts which she could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age; it is further,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Petitioner pay the cost of this proceeding incurred, for which execution may issue.

Comes your Petitioner, Andrew Boykin, and shows unto this Honorable Court as follows, viz:-

1. That he is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama.
2. That he is the father of Hazel Gleniece Boykin, a minor, over the age of eighteen years, whose mother is dead, and that the said minor has no legal guardian.
3. That the said Hazel Gleniece Boykin will not attain the age of twenty-one years until December 5, 1961.
4. That the said Hazel Gleniece Boykin is earning her own livelihood, is well developed for her age mentally and physically, and that she is fully able, competent and capable of transacting her own business, to contract and be contracted with, and to buy and sell real estate, and to otherwise conduct her own affairs as if twenty-one years of age, and that it will be to her best interest to have her disabilities of non-age removed.

WHEREFORE, THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Petitioner prays that a copy of this petition be served upon the said minor in accordance with law, and the Rules and Statutes in such cases made and provided; that the Court will thereafter order, adjudge and decree that the said minor, Hazel Gleniece Boykin, be relieved of her disabilities of non-age, after hearing of such evidence as to the Court is meet and proper, and that thereafter, she be vested with the right to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts that she can lawfully do if she were twenty-one years of age.
