It is further ordered that ROBERT PAUL the RESPONDENT pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

Comes WILMA McCLAIN PAUL by KATIE A. McCLAIN, her mother as natural guardian and next friend, respectfully represents unto Your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That Wilma McClain Paul, Complainant, is over the age of 16 and a resident of Alabama, and have been all her life; The Respondent Robert Paul is over the age of 21 and a resident of Alabama and have been all his life.

2.

That your Complainant, Wilma McClain Paul and the Respondent, Robert Paul, married in Bay Minette, Alabama on August 16, 1958 and lived together as husband and wife in Alabama, until November 22, 1958.

3.

That on November 22, 1958, and on several occasions prior thereto the respondent threatened and abused the complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the respondent was such as to give the complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she

did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

4.

There are no children as fruits of this marriage between Wilma McClain Paul and Robert Paul, and none expected, and no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your complainant prays that your HOnor will by proper procedure make the said Robert Paul, party respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant Wilma McClain Paul by Katie A. McClain, her mother as natural guardian and next friend, further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the respondent; Your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

We were married in Bay Minette, Alabama on August 16, 1958, and lived together as husband and wife in Alabama until on or about November 22, 1958, at which time the Respondent threatened and abused me, trying to do actual violence to my person so that I became in fear of my life or health, and knew that if I continued to live with him that he would injure me so that my life and health would be damaged. I have not lived with him as husband and wife since that day and will never live with him as his wife any more. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I respectfully ask this Honorable Court for a divorce.

My name is Mildred Keeton. I know both parties to this cause. The Complainant is over the age of 16 and the Respondent is over the age of 21. They have been residing in Alabama all of their life. They were married in Bay Minette, Alabama, on August 16, 1958, and lived together as husband and wife in Alabama until on or about November 22, 1958, at which time the Respondent threatened and abused Wilma, the Complainant trying to do actual violence to her so that she became in fear of her life or health and knew that if she continued to live with him that he would injure her so that her life and health would be damaged, and she was forced to leave him. She has never lived with him as his wife since that day. I do not believe they will ever live together again. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.
