This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on ANSWER AND WAIVER and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said

ROBERT LEE TROUP is forever divorced from the said AMY REBECCA TROUP for and on account of

ABANDONMENT. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Stipulated Agreement, which agreement is a part of the Bill of Complaint, pertaining to property settlement, custody of minor children and support and maintenance of minor children, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Robert Lee Troup the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

TESTIMONY OF ROBERT LEE TROUP:

My name is Robert Lee Troup and I am the Complainant in the above styled cause. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Silverhill, Baldwin County, Alabama.

I was married to the Respondent on the 15th day of January, 1947 at Fairhope, Alabama. I had previously been married to Respondent in Birmingham, Alabama but was divorced from that marriage. We were remarried at the insistence of the Respondent that a reconciliation could be made. However, the marriage was entirely unsatisfactory and although the Respondent and I have lived under the same roof since that marriage, we have not lived as husband and wife and have had no marital relations for approximately ten years. We have occupied separate rooms and beds and have not recognized each other in any manner as husband and wife for more than one year next preceding the filing of this cause and have not done so for many years prior to this date.

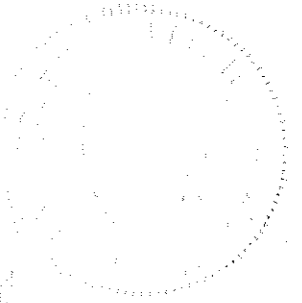

FIRST:

That your Complainant and the Respondent are over the age of twenty-one years and are resident citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing at RFD, Silverhill, Baldwin County, Alabama.

SECOND:

That the Complainant and Respondent were married at Fairhope, Alabama on the 15th day of January, 1947, and lived together as husband and wife until, on account of the matters hereinafter complained of, your Complainant lived separate and apart from the Respondent. Complainant avers that said Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of Complainant for more than one year next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint, since which time Complainant and Respondent have not lived together nor in any way

recognized each other as husband and wife. Complainant further avers that they have had no husband and wife relationship since more than one year next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint between the Complainant and Respondent.

THIRD:

That there were born of this marriage between Complainant and Respondent the following named minor children, viz: Betty Jane Troup, age seventeen years and Charles Leslie Troup, age nineteen years; that the Complainant and Respondent have and are jointly possessed of certain real and personal property. The Complainant further avers that Complainant and Respondent have heretofore entered into an agreement pertaining to the care, custody and control of the said minor children and the disposition of real and personal property between themselves; a copy of which agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Bill of Complaint as if set forth herein.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF:

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that the above named Amy Rebecca Troup be made a party Defendant to this cause by the usual writ or process of this Honorable Court requiring her to appear and plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and under the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause Your Honor will confirm the agreement attached hereto as to the care, custody and control of the said minor children and the disposition of the real and personal property jointly held by the parties that Your Honor will also grant unto your Complainant an absolute divorce from said Respondent and will decree that the parties be allowed to remarry if they see fit. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to him such other, further and different relief to which he may be entitled and as in duty bound he will ever pray.

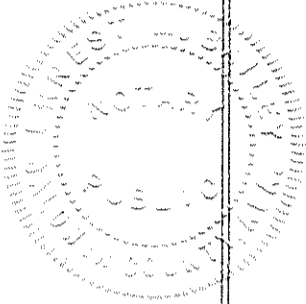

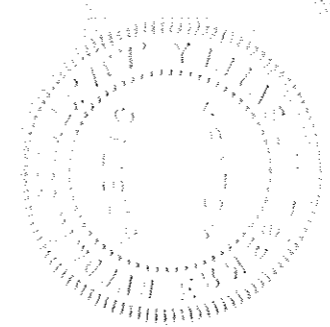

STIPULATED AGREEMENT

It is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1.

That the Respondent shall have the full care, custody and control of the minor children of this marriage, viz: Betty Jane Troup and Charles Leslie Troup, and the Complainant shall pay to Respondent the sum of \$35.00 per month until such time as the said minor child, Betty Jane Troup, shall reach her eighteenth birthday.

2.

The parties are jointly possessed of certain real and personal property located in Baldwin County, Alabama and which property the parties hereto agree to dispose of as follows:

REAL PROPERTY

The Complainant shall convey to Respondent that certain parcel of land being the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T6S, R3E, containing 40 acres, more or less. Together with all improvements located thereon and consisting of a dwelling house and all out-buildings.

The Respondent shall convey to Complainant that certain parcel of land being the NE $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 20, T6S, R3E, containing 40 acres, more or less.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

The Complainant, for and in consideration of the agreements herein stated, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Respondent all his right, title and interest in and to the following personal property:

- (1) 1948 model Chevrolet automobile
- (1) 1941 model Plymouth automobile
- (1) 1950 model 3/4 T. Ford truck
- (4) Junk automobiles, together with (3) Plymouth motors
- (1) W. C. Allis Tractor

together with cultivators

- (1) Oliver planter
  - (1) Disk and harrow
  - (3) Cows together with calves
- All household furnishings located on the premises occupied by Respondent including (1) television and (1) radio.
- (1) Combine
  - (1) Crib of corn
  - (1) Sow with 9 head of shoats
  - (1) Grain drill.

The Respondent for and in consideration of the agreements herein set out does hereby convey to the Complainant all her right, title and interest in and to the following personal property:

- (1) Allis tractor with cultivators
- (1) 1956 model Chervolet 1 1/2 T. truck
- (2) Cows together with calves
- (1) Chain hoist
- (1) Television set with table or stool
- (1) 1950 model Chervolet automobile
- (1) 1946 model Ford automobile
- (1) 1949 model Ford Motor

It is further stipulated and agreed that the Complainant shall farm and harvest, should he desire, the crop of corn located on the real property herein conveyed to the Respondent and that the Respondent shall have the right to farm and harvest a patch of cucumbers as are presently growing on the real property hereinabove conveyed to the Complainant.

3.

In the event either party to this agreement shall institute divorce proceedings, this agreement and the stipulations herein contained may be made a part of such proceedings and the Court having jurisdiction of said proceedings may confirm and ratify the agreement.
