DECREE APPROVING FINAL SETTLEMENT AND DISCHARGING GUARDIAN

This cause coming on to be heard upon the sworn petition of Edith Maxine Deck, as guardian of the Estate of Grady Dwight Deck and Deborah Ann Deck, minors, for her final discharge as said guardian and for the discharge of the sureties on her bond:

And it appearing to the Court that Grady Dwight Deck is now over the age of 21 years and that Deborah Ann Deck is a minor over the age of 18 years whose disabilities of non-age have been removed by a decree rendered by this Court on the *26th* day of August, 1965, and that said Grady Dwight Deck and Deborah Ann Deck have filed a paper in writing in this Court waiving notice of said petition for final settlement, and waiving the filing of vouchers and receipts by the guardian as to her acts and doings as such guardian, consenting that said settlement be made and acknowledging full payment and receipt of all money and other property due them from said guardian, and consenting that said settlement be had without further notice to them; and that said guardian and sureties on her bond be discharged;

And it further appearing to the Court that Sherman Hinote and O. P. Grubbs as sureties on the bond of said guardian have filed papers in writing in this Court waiving notice of said petition and consenting that said guardian be discharged without further notice to them;

And it further appearing to the Court that all Court costs in this administration of said guardianship have been paid, including the costs of this final settlement;
