IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECREED THAT THE COMPLAINANT HEREIN IS GRANTED THE RIGHT TO RESUME THE USE OF HER MAIDEN NAME OF ADDIE ELIZABETH HUGGINS.

It is futher ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is futher ordered that ADDIE ELIZABETH HUGGINS POWELL the COMPLAINANT pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

The Respondent admits the allegations as to the ages, marriage and residence, but denies all other allegations contained in the bill of complaint, and demands strict proof of the same.

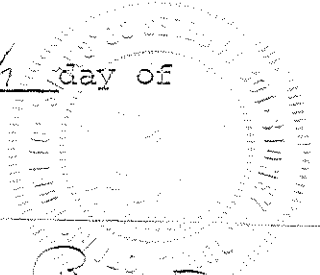

I know that we shall never live together again as husband and wife, and I respectfully ask the court to grant to me the right to resume the use of my maiden name of Addie Elizabeth Huggins.

My name is Mrs. Ruby Huggins. I know both parties to this cause. The complainant is over the age of 18 and the respondent is over the age of 21. The Complainant has been a resident of Alabama all her life, and the respondent is presently residing in California. They were married at Bay Minette, Alabama on December 15, 1956 and lived in Alabama until the respondent abandoned the complainant without fault on her part on or about february 13, 1958. they have not lived together as husband and wife since that date. There are no children as fruits of their marriage and they have no property to be divided. I do not believe they will ever live together as husband and wife any more.
