On December 24, 1957, Mr. D. O. Fowler and I entered into a purchase agreement which is handed herewith and attached to this testimony hereto and made a part of said testimony. This agreement is recorded in Deed Book 270, page 546 being filed on October 4, 1958, in the Probate Office of Baldwin County, Alabama. The agreement provides for the sale by Mr. D. O. Fowler to me of the property described in this petition the description being set out in the agreement and said property lies in Baldwin County, Alabama. The terms of the agreement show the purchase price of said lands to be Eight Hundred Sixty-four (\$864.00) Dollars and which sum has been paid in accordance with the payments acknowledged in the said agreement and the payments acknowledged by the signature of Mr. D. O. Fowler two original receipts given by Mr. D. O. Fowler to me, the petitioner in this cause. I have paid the entire purchase price in full and have made demand of Mr. D. O. Fowler that he execute a warranty deed conveying said property to me clear of all incumbrances. These demands have been made on more than one occasion and Mr. D. O. Fowler has failed or refused to comply with the terms of the contract by executing a warranty deed conveying said property to me.

I respectfully ask this Honorable Court by proper decree to order the Clerk of this Honorable Court to execute by proper conveyance said lands to me.

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted for a final decree upon the original bill of complaint filed October 5, 1959, decree pro confesso against the Defendant, D. O. Fowler, and testimony of Newton W. McIntyre, the Complainant herein; and certain exhibits, being: the original purchase contract duly executed by D. O. Fowler and Newton W. McIntyre and signed receipts for the full amount payable under the contract, which provided for sale by D. O. Fowler to Newton W. McIntyre of the following described lands:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter of Section 32. Township 3 South, Range 3 East, run thence North 177 feet to the North side of a dirt road, thence East along the North line of said dirt road 567 feet to a point which is the Southwest corner of lands conveyed by J. L. Jones to the grantor herein, thence continuing Eastwardly along the North side of said public road 229 feet to the Southwest corner of lands conveyed by grantor to J. C. Mosley, thence North 190 feet to the Northwest corner of lands conveyed to J. C. Mosley for a point of beginning; thence North 218 feet, more or less to the North line of the lands conveyed to grantor by J. L. Jones; thence East along the said line 95 feet; thence South 218 feet to the Northeast corner of lands conveyed by grantor to J. C. Mosley; thence West, along the North line of the J. C. Mosley land, 95 feet to the point of beginning;

the description of which was set forth in the complaint herein, as noted by the Register.

The Court is, therefore, after considering all of the pleadings and the testimony, of the opinion and to the conclusion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for:

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the said D. O. Fowler having been paid in full by said Complainant, Newton W. McIntyre, the said Respondent, D. O. Fowler, by a proper conveyance, convey to the Complainant, which, according to the testimony in the record is the same property as described in the contract of sale or offer to purchase entered into by and between the Complainant and the Respondent, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 3 East, run thence North 177 feet to the North side of a dirt road, thence East along the North line of said dirt road 567 feet to a point which is the Southwest corner of lands conveyed by J. L. Jones to the grantor herein, thence continuing Eastwardly along the

North side of said public road 229 feet to the Southwest corner of lands conveyed by grantor to J. C. Mosley, thence North 190 feet to the Northwest corner of lands conveyed to J. C. Mosley for a point of beginning; thence North 218 feet, more or less to the North line of the lands conveyed to grantor by J. L. Jones; thence East along the said line 95 feet; thence South 218 feet to the Northeast corner of lands conveyed by grantor to J. C. Mosley; thence West, along the North line of the J. C. Mosley land, 95 feet to the point of beginning.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that if the Respondent should fail or refuse to execute proper conveyance and deliver abstract of title to the property involved within thirty days from the date hereof, then the Register of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, is authorized, directed and empowered to execute proper conveyance to the Complainant, conveying all of the right, title and interest that the Complainant had, or has in and to said property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Respondent be, and he hereby is taxed with the cost herein, for which execution may issue.

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT H. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY SITTING:

Comes your Complainant, Mary Odessa Hughes, and humbly complaining against Lewis Young Hughes, Defendant, and respectfully shows unto your Honor:

FIRST: That your Complainant is over the age of twentyone years and is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama,
where she has resided for more than twelve months next preceding
the filing of this bill of complaint.

SECOND: That the said Defendant is over the age of twentyone years and is a resident of the City of Foley, Baldwin County,
Alabama.

THIRD: That your Complainant and the said Defendant were married in the City of Lucedale, Mississippi, on the 27th day of August, 1952, and lived together as husband and wife until on or about the 30th day of May, 1959.

FOURTH: That to this marriage were born two children, namely: Lewis Young Hughes, Jr., age five years, and Larry Wayne Hughes, age four months, both of whom are in the care and custody of your Complainant.

Defendant is a man of violent and ungovernable temper and frequently becomes enraged, and when so enraged is a dangerous man and often has become enraged at your Complainant, without just cause and reasonable excuse, and has cursed and abused this Complainant and threatened to kill her; that on the 30th day of May, 1959, while your Complainant was with child, the said Defendant hit this Com-

plainant with his fist and slung her about the porch of their house, which took place at three of clock in the morning, when he the said Defendant came home in a drunken condition in the company of another woman, whose name is unknown to your Complainant; that on the 4th day of July, 1959, at the filing station operated by the Defendant in the City of Foley, Baldwin County, Alabama, in the presence of others the said Defendant struck at the Complainant and threatened to cut her throat and to kill her with a club which he held in his hand at the time, and did curse and abuse your Complainant; that from such conduct she has every reasonable apprehension to believe and does believe that should she continue to live with him he would inflict grave bodily injury upon her attendant with danger to her life and health.

SIXTH: That the said Defendant is able bodied, in good health and owns and operates a filing station in the City of Foley, Baldwin County, Alabama, from such operation clears at least Five Hundred Dollars monthly and owns real estate in Baldwin County, Alabama, and is amply able to make suitable, proper and sufficient contribution to your Complainant for her support and for the support of their said children, and for her cost incurred herein, including a reasonable attorney's fee.

WHEREFORE, your Complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint, and make the said Lewis Young Hughes party Defendant hereto and by appropriate process require him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by this Honorable Court; that your Honor will order a reference to determine alimony pendente lite, and attorney's fees to be paid by the Defendant to your Complainant.

Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between this Complainant and the said Defendant; and that your Complainant be awarded such
